

Its design is based on three main materials : brass, wood and wool. Brass is used for the frame of the headboard because it is easily machinable and allows to create curves. Woold is a local material providing strength and durability to the bed and wool is a symbol of softness and comfort.

Padded wool cushions bring softness, comfort and a feeling of well-being to the user. The wood supports the mattress and frames the bed, giving it a warm touch. Brass is used to create a rounded headboard, inspired by the Art Deco movement.

The design of the LUNA bed was inspired by both a need for softness and a desire to be closer to nature. A design choice that favors the comfort and the durability of the bed, which seeks to look and feel softer and cozier than ever.

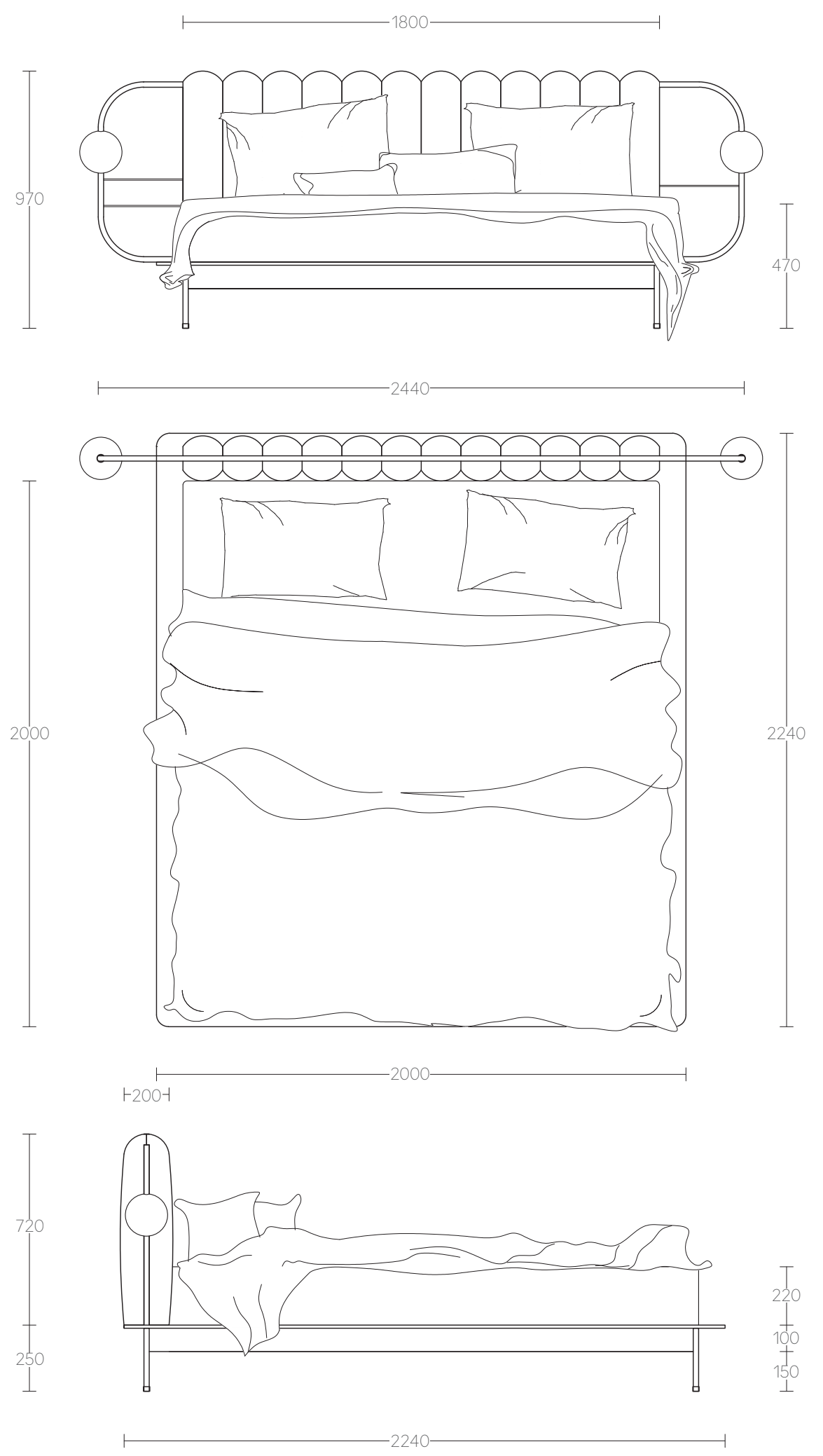
The mattress is surrounded by a wooden rim on which soft cushions rest, inducing a state of pure relaxation. The downy lining emphasizes the shape of the cushions of the headboard that invite comfort and reassurance.

- 1 Thin metal sticks allow the user to drop magazines, books, glasses or headphones after reading or relaxing.
- 2 The two luminous balls on both sides of the headboard provide a soft light and give the user a great visual comfort to read or relax.
- 3 The headboard filled with Swiss sheep wool and covered with curly wool brings comfort but also a great softness to the user.
